



## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **How many mobilities are on offer?**

In this first round of mobilities there are 8 places on the 14-week and 22 places on the 2-week mobilities. For the 14-week mobilities, pairs of trainees travel and work together at each of the 4 EU destinations. The 2-week mobility teams will be accompanied by a member of Ambios Ltd UK and during the 14-week mobilities you will also receive a visit from our team.

### **Are all the mobilities the same?**

There are 2-week and 14-week mobilities to our network of EU nature conservation partners. The timetables for each are all different and if you are successful and come to the 1-week residential we'll talk with you more about the specific details for each mobility.

### **On the 14-week mobilities, can I take time off (come home for my graduation)?**

These mobilities are work based learning where you are immersed in a real work environment working alongside professional staff. Your leisure time while on mobility is entirely up to you. If you can negotiate time off from your Host organisation and your absence is swift with guarantee of return, where you decide to go is entirely your choice.

### **What support should I expect?**

Our overall philosophy is to create a supportive learning environment around all our operations both in the UK and EU. The Ambios UK team are here to support you while you are on programme (3-week and 15-week) and we have a dedicated pastoral support officer with whom you'll be in contact once every 2-weeks while you are on mobility. You can also contact us at any time while on mobility.

### **When will I have to pay?**

If you are successful at interview stage and offered a place you will need to pay the full amount within 21 days.

### **Are there are more mobilities planned for 2019/2020?**

Yes, we are currently at the planning stage for a second round of two week mobilities to Italy, Hungary and Portugal and these will be announced on our website as soon as possible

### **Will the course run again in 2020?**

Yes. While the exact dates may change the same programme will run in 2020.

### **Do I have to be a UK citizen to take part in this training programme?**

No, you need to be a 'UK resident'. That is, you need to be able to prove that you are legally entitled to be in the UK and you need a UK residential addresses to be able to access the Erasmus+ element of the programme.
